## THE SPECIAL CLASS

" REX "

THE the new super-liner of the Italian Line, is one of the largest vessels launched since the War; the spaciousness, the technical perfection of her construction and machinery render her one of the most superb products of Marine structure.

 **FONDAZIONE ANSALDO**  
Measuring 880 ft. in length, and 102 ft. beam, she has a gross tonnage of 51.000 tons. Four groups of turbine-motors driving her four screws give her a speed exceeding 27 knots.

The construction of the vessel with her watertight compartments guarantees the absolute safety and regularity of navigation. In the event of fire, the vessel is fitted with a complete group of fire-extinguishing devices, and a fire brigade equipped with special appliances. Twentyfour life-boats, 22 of which are motor-launches, and 4 furnished with Marconi installations, constitute the vessels complement, capable of holding comfortably the maximum of persons on board.



## THE HALL

The center of the social life of the Special Class. A spacious saloon of austere beauty, the Hall has doors opening onto the verandahs on either side, and two wrought-iron gates communicating with the Ladies saloon.

The unusual spaciousness and luxury of the saloons, and the exceptional comfort of every room render the Special Class of the "REX" the best of its kind.

The service has been perfected with the utmost care to the smallest detail. Ventilation is abundantly provided; electricity is used unsparingly for lighting, signalling, for passenger and service elevators. The installation of baths and showers is in a proportion surpassing all that has gone before. There is also a series of cabins provided with private baths.



The principal Saloons all meet on A deck, connected by a commodious staircase and two elevators to B deck, on which is the Dining Saloon, and to C deck where are the cabins and Chapel. The after part of the Saloon deck is given up to the Open-air Swimming Pool and Lido of the Special Class, with Verandah-Café and Gymnasium. So that there are 4 decks for the use of the Special Class, with perfect arrangement of rooms.

The decorations and furnishing maintain a happy medium of simple beauty, which does not exclude richness of materials, designed and carried out by the architects Ducrot of Palermo and Monti of Milan.

The luxuriousness, the furnishing, and the minute care which has been taken with the smallest details of the cabins, offer the most perfect conditions of comfort to the guests.



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An imposing staircase connects the various decks on which the Special Class is disposed. The staircase ascends from the Hall to the vestibule on B deck, separated from the Dining Saloon by a large curved glass door.

## DINING SALOON

The Dining saloon can seat 400 persons, and extends right across the ship, with a long line of windows looking onto the sea. Beauty, spaciousness, and airiness together with a richness of decoration and materials, characterize this saloon.

Richly decorated with lacquered panels, this room is reserved for private parties.


THE RESTAURANT

On C deck, on which are situated all the Special Class cabins, is the Entrance Hall with large doors all round the walls. Here also are placed all the offices, the shops, the glass showcases, the entrance to the two wide corridors and the two elevators of this class.




THE EMBARKATION ENTRANCE HALL



## THE CHILDRENS PLAYROOM

A light decoration of bright colors gives this room a gay and fresh aspect. A Marionette-Theater occupies the whole of one wall. It is a veritable children's paradise.



Two large verandahs run along either side of the group of saloons on A deck, with a length of 262 ft. and a width of 16 ft. An uninterrupted line of glass doors and windows give light and air in abundance, and permit the enjoyment of the marvellous view of the sea.

**THE LADIES SALOON**

# THE TOURIST CLASS

This is a class designated for those who wish to travel with a minimum of expense, and at the same time with every comfort and luxury of decorations and furnishing corresponding to each individual taste.

All this is to be found on board the "REX": the Tourist Class, besides its perfect comfort, offers a beauty of decoration and furnishing which is in tone with the rooms and the public. The installations of this class are distributed on the Saloon deck, and on B, C and D decks, connected conveniently and speedily by commodious staircases and an elevator.

The decoration of the Tourist Class is entirely modern. Simplesness, beauty of line, harmony of coloring, and good taste are paramount in every detail of these rooms, and acceptable to every taste. These are principally designed by Giannini of Pistoia.



## THE GRAND VERANDAH

Designed with perfect modern lines this verandah has the aspect of a garden. In the vast curving after wall, a long line of windows open on to the covered promenade. Glass-cases and book-shelves are distributed round the room; and on one side is the large curving counter of the bar.



## THE DINING SALOON



**THE PROMENADE DECK**

The Promenade Deck of the Tourist Class consists of two wide forward terraces with panoramic view embracing the whole horizon and taking in the bows of the ship.



The Venetian Art of the XVIIIth century adapted to modern requirements prevails in the decoration of this saloon; beautiful materials, comfortable sofas and armchairs are placed round delightful lacquered tables. The ensemble is perfectly suited to a drawing room of the Tourist Class.

This is the office where the passengers can comfortably arrange everything connected with embarking and disembarking and for their stay on board ship. It is located in the Entrance Hall on C Deck.


## THE CABINS

Space, comfort, and convenience combined with a pleasing elegance characterize the cabins of the Tourist Class; rendering the voyage one of pleasure. There is an unusual number of baths at disposal of these cabins.



## SMOKING ROOM

A peaceful welcoming room, full of light by reason of its uninterrupted line of large windows along the wall. The decoration is inspired by the neoclassic Italian style; there are panels of polished inlaid wood, and a delightful fire-place in a corner. Along one wall is the bar counter and adjacent verandah.



## ENTRANCE HALL

Here are situated all the shops and offices at the disposal of the passengers, from the Information Bureau to the Photographer, from the barber to the show-cases. It gives access to the wide corridors leading to the cabins, the staircases and to the elevator.
