## PORT INFORMATION

**HYDRA:** A picturesque island famous for its sea-farers and heroes of the War of Independence. Today the playground of artists and café-society, unique for Greek music and handicraft shopping.

**DELOS:** The sacred island of ancient Greeks on which no mortal could be born or die, legendary birthplace of Apollo and Artemis, where the Athenian Republic later kept its treasures. Prosperous commercial center of the Mediterranean, sacked by Mithridates in 88 B.C. and uninhabited since, today the Pompeii of Greece. Exquisite architectural remains of temples, theatre and outstanding mosaics.

**MYKONOS:** The Capi of the Aegean, the island of white houses, windmills, churches and beautiful beaches. A sophisticated international resort where you can enjoy swimming, Greek music and local handicrafts.

**SANTORINI:** A volcanic crescent-shaped island of savage beauty, with precipitous cliffs. Famous site of ancient civilization, believed to be the legendary Atlantis. A terrible eruption destroyed part of the island in the 15th century B.C. You will enjoy the donkey ride and view on the top of the hill and the excellent local wine. A sight never to be forgotten.

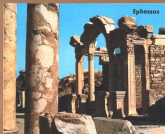
**HERAKLION:** Capital of Crete, largest of the Greek Islands, center of the 5000 year-old Minoan civilization, brought to light by Sir Arthur Evans. Here developed the first organized society of Europe which flourished for a period of some 2000 years. You will visit the Minoan palace of Knossos, one of the highlights of the world's archaeological discoveries, with its Labyrinths, Royal Chambers, theatre etc. and find the vivid remnants of Minoan Crete in the Museum of Heraklion, the most spectacular in Greece. Crete became prosperous again during the Venetian occupation which ended in 1669 and gave to the world one of its greatest painters: Domenico Theotokopoulos, known as "El Greco". "Joie de vivre" characterized the Cretans throughout history and is still their leit-motiv.

**RHODES:** You enter the port, once dominated by the Colossus of Rhodes, one of the seven wonders of the world. This beautiful island, center of old civilization, remained cosmopolitan and gay throughout the centuries. Famous in antiquity for its university of philosophy, rhetoric and law, where even great Romans like Cicero and Julius Caesar studied. Visit the imposing Castle of Temple Knights of St. John and the Museum. Excursion to the fascinating Acropolis of Lindos. Wonderful bathing and leisurely duty-free shopping in the colourful bazaars.

**KUSADASI:** Excursion to Ephessos built, according to legend, by the Amazons in the second millenium B.C. Later seized by the Ionians who built the great Temple of Artemis (Diana) another of the original seven wonders of the world. Visit the Cathedral of St. John, the ruins of Ephessos, - the Theatre, Stadium, Library of Celsus, Temple of Serapis - and the new excavations undertaken by the Austrian Archaeological School.

**ISTANBUL:** The Pearl of the Bosphorus, crossroad between East and West, with its 500 Mosques, innumerable forts and palaces of the Sultans. Turkey's largest city and a thriving metropolis for over 1600 years, it was chosen in the 4th century by Constantine the Great as the Capital of the Romans. Here flourished the Eastern Roman Empire, later known as Byzantium. Visit the Sultan Ahmed famous Blue Mosque, the Church "Aghia Sophia", Museum, Souleymanie Mosque and fabulous Topkapi with its innumerable treasures and jewels. Other highlights are the Dolmabahce Palace, Kaariye Mosque the Archaeological Museum and naturally the Bazaar with its hundreds of streets and thousands of shops full of the wealth of the Orient.

## GENERAL INFORMATION

**PASSAGE CONTRACT:** The attention of passengers is drawn to the General Conditions of transportation set out in the Passage Contract.

**CRUISE RATES INCLUDE:** 1. Accommodation and all meals on board commencing with lunch or dinner on the first day and terminating with breakfast on the last day.

2. Services of qualified guides speaking English, French, Italian and German, and services of multi-lingual Cruise Staff.

**CRUISE RATES DO NOT INCLUDE:** 1. Shore excursions. 2. Rent of Deck Chairs. 3. Drinks, laundry and other items of personal nature. 4. Gratuities on board.

**CANCELLATION:** Article 2 of the Passage Contract specifies that in the event of the passenger cancelling his passage, or not using it for the sailing for which it was issued, passage money will not be refunded. Only if the space reserved is resold will the passage money be refunded less 75% to cover Agents' commission and expenses.

**CANCELLATION OF CRUISES OR ALTERATION OF ITINERARY:** The Company reserves the right to cancel any Cruise, in which case the passage money will be refunded. The Company also reserves the right to alter the itinerary of any Cruise if this should become necessary or desirable for any reason. Times of arrival and departure at the various ports of call are given as a general guide, but no guarantee can be given that they will be adhered to.

**PASSPORTS:** All passengers must hold an open-date Passport valid for the countries to be visited.

**DOMESTIC AIRFARE:** Domestic airfares will be provided on board.

**LIABILITY AND INSURANCE:** The conveyance of passengers, their luggage and personal property is subject to the terms and conditions printed on the Passage Contract.

In accepting the Contract, the passenger agrees to the terms and conditions stated therein.

**TICKETS:** Tickets for the convenience of the passengers, the ship's Purser accepts for deposit in the ship's safe, against receipt, valuables such as jewelry, money or documents which should be delivered in a sealed envelope. Here again, the liability of the Company is limited to the conditions of the Passage Contract.

**DECK CHAIRS AND BUNGS:** May be hired on board for use during the voyage on application to the Deck Steward.

**ELECTRIC CURRENT:** The electric current on board (teaps etc.) is 220 V AC.
