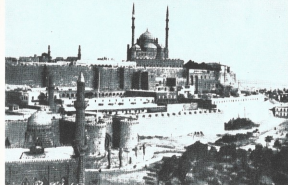

## 1964 - 1965 14-DAY MEDITERRANEAN CRUISE PROGRAM AND OPTIONAL SHORE EXCURSIONS FOR THE 5 CRUISES

**1st DAY, SUN.** Sailing from **NAPLES** at 16:00 hrs.

**2nd DAY, MON.** Arrive **MALTA** at 13:00 hrs.

Christianity was introduced to Malta by the ship-wrecked St. Paul in the year 60 A. D. and this is evident in her churches, shrines and catacombs. The entire population of the island was awarded the Victoria Cross for their magnificent courage through 2000 air raids during World War II.

### OPTIONAL EXCURSION:

**1 -** Half-day (afternoon) sightseeing drive of the city, including visit to the underground Temple of Tarsian and the ancient town of Medina. Return via Mosta and visit to the third greatest Dome of Europe. Continuation to Valletta and visit of the Palace of the Grand Masters and St. John's Cathedral. **US\$ 5—**

**2nd DAY, MON.** Sail from Malta at 19:00 hrs.

**3rd DAY, TUE.** At sea.

**4th DAY, WED.** At sea.

**5th DAY, THU.** Arrive **ALEXANDRIA** at 07:00 hrs.

The day is spent at this exciting port of call.

### OPTIONAL EXCURSIONS:

**2 -** Half-day (morning) sightseeing drive of Alexandria by motorcoach and guide, visiting Pompeii's Pillar, the Serapeum, the Catacombs of Kom El Shugafa, the Greek Roman Museum, Nouzha Gardens and Ras El-Tin Palace. **US\$ 3—**

**3 -** Two-day excursion: Alexandria - Cairo - Ismailia - Port Said by motorcoach and guide.

**First Day:** After short sightseeing drive of Alexandria, proceed to Cairo and visit of the Pyramids and the Sphinx. After lunch at the Hotel, visit of the Mohamed Ali Mosque and the Bazaar. Dinner and overnight at the Hotel Omar Khayam (bungelows). (evening free - possibility to participate to a Cairo-by-night tour - attractions and oriental dances at the Hilton recommended as the best).

**Second Day:** After a visit to the Egyptian Museum, the excursion will proceed to Ismailia, where lunch will be served. Arrive Port Said in the early afternoon.

**5th DAY, THU.** Sail from Alexandria at 23:00 hrs.

**6th DAY, FRI.** Arrive **PORT SAID** at 10:00 hrs.

This was once famed as the wickedest city in the world and is still a colorful port where the sights, sounds and wares of the Middle East abound.

**6th DAY, FRI.** Sail from Port Said at 16:00 hrs.

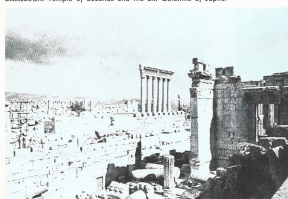
**7th DAY, SAT.** Arrive **BEIRUT** at 08:00 hrs.

#### OPTIONAL EXCURSIONS:

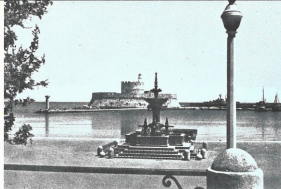
- 4 - Full day excursion: Beirut - Baalbek - Damascus by private car and guide. See Lebanon's renowned summer resorts en route to fabulous Baalbek. After visiting the well preserved ruins, proceed across the Syrian Border to Damascus, arriving in time for lunch. After sightseeing of Damascus, including the Omayyad Mosque, the Tomb of St. John, King Solomon's Tomb, the Bozaar, the Palace of El Azem and St. Paul's Church, return to Beirut in the evening. **US\$ 23.50**

- 5 - Three-day excursion: Beirut - Baalbek - Damascus - Jerusalem - Tel Aviv - Jaffa - Haifa by private car and guide.

First Day: After short sightseeing drive of the city of Beirut in the morning, the excursion will proceed to Baalbek for a visit to the fabulous ruins. Then on to Damascus, where lunch will be served. Afternoon sightseeing of the city of Damascus, including visit to the Omayyad Mosque, the Bozaars, etc. Dinner and overnight at the Hotel Semiramis.

Second Day: Depart in the morning for Jerusalem via Amman, the capital of Jordan, where lunch will be served. In the afternoon, visit to the most important Christian shrines, the Via Dolorosa, the Holy Sepulchre, etc. Return to the Hotel Ambassador for dinner and overnight.

Third Day: Transfer to the Israeli part of Jerusalem, through the Mandelbaum Gate. After lunch, visit to the Hebrew University, Mt. Herzl, Mt. Zion, etc. and proceed to Tel Aviv and Jaffa. After a Jerusalem sightseeing drive of Tel Aviv, the first all-Jewish city of modern times, continue

to Haifa for embarkation in the early evening. **US\$ 114.—**  
(supplement for single room US\$ 5.— per person)  
Sail from Beirut at 02:00 hrs.

8th DAY, SUN. Arrive HAIFA at 08:00 hrs.  
Haifa is Israel's principal harbor and, like the rest of this land, hums with activity.

#### OPTIONAL EXCURSIONS:

- 6 - Half-day (morning) sightseeing drive of Haifa by motorcoach and guide, including visit of the port, the Technological Institute, the Temple of Bahay and the Cave of Prophet Elijah on Mount Carmel, from where you get a marvellous view of the city and its harbor. **US\$ 4.50**

7 - Full day excursion: Haifa - Tel Aviv - Jerusalem by motorcoach and guide. Drive along the coastal road to ancient Caesarea to the plain of Sharon where Tel Aviv is situated. After a brief sightseeing drive of the city, continue via Ramle and the Judean Hills to Jerusalem. After lunch visit of Jerusalem, including Mount Zion, the Tomb of King David and the Church of the Assumption of the Virgin. Return to Haifa via Ain Kerin and Lod. **US\$ 16.—**

8 - Full day excursion: Haifa - Nazareth - Tiberias by motorcoach and guide. After short sightseeing drive through Haifa and Mount Carmel, the excursion will proceed to Nazareth. Visit of the Church of the Annunciation, Joseph's workshop, the Fountain of the Blessed Virgin, etc. Continue to Tiberias and the Sea of Galilee. After lunch, at En-Gin-Kibutz, the excursion will proceed to the Plain of Genezareth, Tabgha, and will return to Haifa via Mount Tabor. **US\$ 15.—**

9 - Half-day (morning) excursion by motorcoach and guide to Lindos, one of the three doric cities of the isle, very picturesque with its narrow and steep alleys. Visit of the Theatre, Temple and Castle.

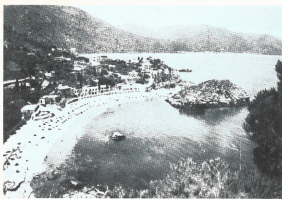

# m.s. STELLA SOLARIS

## GENERAL INFORMATION

**PASSAGE CONTRACTS:** The attention of the passenger is drawn to the General Conditions of transportation set out in the Passage Contract.

**CANCELLATION:** Article 2 of the Passage Contract specifies that in the event of the passenger cancelling his passage or not using it for the sailing for which it was issued, passage money will not be refunded. Only if the space released is re-sold will the passage money be refunded less 10% to cover Agents' commissions and expenses.

**CANCELLATION OF CRUISES OR ALTERATION OF ITINERARY:** The Company reserves the right to cancel any Cruise, in which case the passage money will be refunded. The company also reserves the right to alter the itinerary of any Cruise if this should become necessary or desirable for any reason. Times of arrival and departure at the various ports of call are given as a general guide, but no guarantee can be given that they will be adhered to.

**PASSPORTS:** All passengers must hold an up-to-date passport valid for the countries to be visited.

**EMBARKATION:** The m.s. STELLA SOLARIS sails from NAPLES Sunday at 1600 hrs. Embarkation starts at 1400 hrs.

**DOMESTIC ANIMALS:** Domestic animals will not be allowed on board the m.s. STELLA SOLARIS.

**LIABILITY AND INSURANCE:** The conveyance of passengers, their luggage and personal property is subject to the terms and conditions printed on the Passage Contract. In accepting the Contract, the passenger agrees to the terms and conditions stated therein.

**VALUABLES:** For the convenience of the passengers, the ship's Purser accepts for deposit in the ship's safe against receipt, valuables such as jewelry, money or documents which should be delivered in a sealed envelope. Here again, the liability of the Company is limited to the conditions of the Passage Contract.

**DECK CHAIRS, RUGS AND CUSHIONS** may be hired on board for use during the voyage on application to the Deck Steward.

**ELECTRIC CURRENT:** The electric current in the cabins of the m.s. STELLA SOLARIS (razors, etc) is 220V DC.

**MAIL FOR PASSENGERS:** Letters, etc., intended for passengers should be addressed in the following manner: . . . . . (Full Names) m.s. STELLA SOLARIS . . . . . (Arrival/Sailing Date) c/o . . . . . While every effort is made to distribute mail, no responsibility is accepted by the Company for non-delivery, mis-delivery or delay. Sender's name and address should also be shown in order to facilitate return in the event of non-delivery.

**DISSEMBARKATION:** Passengers cannot disembark at any port other than Naples. Passengers electing to leave or join the cruise en route are advised that they may be assessed port dues, levies or taxes imposed by the respective port authorities.
